HOMEWORK EXPECTATION

The homework set by teachers at Coppice Valley may differ in each year group. The purpose of the homework is for children to practise and embed their learning ensuring quick recall of key facts and knowledge and developing their fluency in their reading and comprehension.



YEAR 1

READING AND KEY WORDS

Children are encouraged to read their reading book daily with an adult. Alongside their reading, the children should be practising their reading and spelling of key words for the half term. These are made available on the class page on the school website.

YEAR 2

READING AND TIMES TABLE ROCKSTARS

Children are encouraged to read their reading book daily with an adult. As children progress through the year they will begin to learn their 2s, 5s and 10 times tables. Each child will be given a log in for Times Table Rockstars to support their learning and develop fluency of their times tables.

YEAR 3 & 4

READING AND TIMES TABLE ROCKSTARS

Children are expected to continue reading their reading book alongside practising their times tables on Times Table Rockstars. By year 4, children will know all times tables facts to 12 and should be working on their fluency and recall.



READING AND CENTURY TECH

Children should continue to read their reading book with an adult. Children will also be given individual access to Century Tech to support their learning in school.



READING, CENTURY TECH AND ADDITIONAL SATS PREPARATION

Children should continue reading with an adult and accessing Century Tech to support their learning in school. As the children progress through the year, they will be given additional workbooks to support and prepare for their SATs.
