QUALITY OF EDUCATION

To be outstanding...next steps

- Ensure teachers have a strong knowledge of key stage objectives across the curriculum, to support pupils to achieve or exceed the expected standard.
- Embed the new English curriculum, including the new phonics scheme Little Wandle, so that pupil outcomes improve.

BEHAVIOUR AND ATTITUDES

To be outstanding... next steps

- Introduce Zones of Regulation across the whole school, so that children understand the complex skill of regulation and pupil well-being is improved.
- Promote attendance, aiming for 97% across the whole school.

PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT

To be outstanding...next steps

- E-safety & risk taking is prioritised in the PSHE curriculum so that pupils behave more safely out of school.
- Coppice Gold award promoted, in upper KS2, so that pupils have opportunity to develop their character.
